The Stanford Fund Partnership Program

The Stanford Fund Partnership Program (TSFPP), for undergraduate student organizations, has an adjusted timeline this Summer quarter to access funding for the 2021-22 academic year. We are replacing our TSFPP workshops with the Stanford Training and Registration System learning management system (STARS) to increase student access to training resources.

July 15, 2021: Thursday, July 15th - STARS Training Opens

July 21, 2021: FOs must complete STARS Training & submit application rough draft for feedback & review by OSE team

August 2, 2021: Applications are due - submit via granted.stanford.edu

Week of August 17th: Notification of funding allocations

To make the event more accessible, the fair will also be hosted virtually in CardinalEngage. We highly encourage you to participate in both to maximize engagement and outreach.

- **Thursday, September 30:** Health and Wellness, Community Service, Social Awareness, Political and Arts and Media Student Organizations

Travel Restrictions and Process
